City Directories

City Directories were produced long before the advent of the telephone and remained important into the 1970's. They may include such information as:

- heads of household
- occupations
- local businesses
- addresses
- advertisements

Thus they are important research tools for local historians and genealogists.

Ridgewood's City Directories, which cover many towns, are now available on microfilm in the Reference area of the Library.
