Academic Search Premier

Multi-disciplinary database provides full-text for more than 8,500 journals, including full text for more than 4,600 peer-reviewed titles.

Biography Collection Complete

Comprehensive collection of more than 177,000 full-text biographies from many sources

Business Source-Elite

Provides full-text for nearly 1000 business publications covering business, management, economics, finance, banking, accounting and much more.

Business Source-Premier

Industry's more popular business research database, providing full-text for more than 2,300 journals. Superior coverage of all disciplines of business, including marketing, management, finance and economics.

ERIC

Contains more than 1,300,000 records and links to more than 323,000 full-text documents from *ERIC* dating back to 1966.

Funk & Wagnall's New World Encyclopedia

This database provides over 25,000 encyclopedia entries covering a variety of subject areas.

GreenFILE

Provides information covering all aspects of human impact on the environment. Topics include global warming, green building, pollution, renewable energy, recycling and more.

Health Source- Consumer Edition

Provides searchable full text for over 80 journals covering such topics as medical sciences, food sciences and nutrition, childcare, sports medicine and general health.

Health Source-Nursing/Academic Edition

Provides nearly 550 scholarly full-text journals focusing on many medical disciplines. Includes the *Lexi-PAL Drug Guide*, which covers 1,300 generic drug patient education sheets with more than 4,700 brand names.

History Reference Center

Full text from more than 1,620 reference books, encyclopedias and nonfiction books. Includes 150 leading history periodicals, 57,000 historical documents, 78,000 biographies of historical figures, with 113,000 photos..

Library, Information Science & Technology Abstracts

Indexes more than 675 periodicals, plus books, research reports and proceedings. Subject coverage includes librarianship, classification, cataloging, online information retrieval, information management and more.

EBSCO Host

Literary Reference Center

Comprehensive database that combines information from over 1,000 books, encyclopedias and other literary resources. Detailed information on the most studied authors and their works.

MAS Ultra—School Edition

Designed specifically for high school libraries, contains full text for nearly 500 popular, high school magazines. Includes reference books, biographies, primary source documents, image collection photos, maps and flags.

MasterFILE— Premier

Multidisciplinary database provides full text for more than 1,700 general reference publications dating as far back as 1975 with primary source docs.

Middle Search Plus

Provides 140 full-text magazines, pamphlets & reference books covering general topics appropriate for middle and junior high school students with primary sources.

Newspaper Source

Contains full text for more than 40 U.S. and international newspapers; Includes full text TV and radio news transcripts and selected full text for 390 regional U.S. papers.

Newspaper Source Plus

includes more than 700 full-text newspapers, providing more than 31 million full-text articles.

Novelist

Readers' advisory fiction database that provides subject heading access, reviews, annotations, and much more for over 150,000 fiction titles.

Primary Search

Full text for nearly 70 popular magazines for elementary school research.

Professional Development Collection

For professional educators, provides a highly specialized collection of 520 high quality education journals, including nearly 350 peer-reviewed titles and more than 200 educational reports.

Regional Business News

Provides comprehensive full text coverage for regional business publications. Incorporates coverage of 80 business journals, newspapers and newswires from all metropolitan and rural areas within the United States.

Science Reference Center

Full text for nearly 640 science encyclopedias, reference books & periodicals.

Teacher Reference Center

Provides indexing & abstracts for 280 of the most popular teacher and administrator journals.

Current events database containing social, political & economic issues, scientific discoveries and other popular topics discussed in today's classrooms from over 399 diverse sources.

Online Resources

What is Available?

As a BCCLS library cardholder, you have access to many online resources which include full-text magazines & newspapers databases and other online resources. In addition, the Ridgewood Public Library also offers in-house use of various electronic resources.

How do I access these resources?

All resources can be accessed from the library and many can be accessed from your home with the use of your 14 digit library barcode number. Unless noted, these resources can be accessed from home.

Can I get the full text?

A majority of the articles available are full-text. This means that you can access the article in its entirety. At times, you may come across articles that provide only a citation or abstract. Please see a Librarian for assistance.

Which online resource should I use?

Although the contents of these databases are different, they basically operate on the same searching principles. Some magazines, newspapers, & reference sources are indexed in more than one database, while others are indexed only in one. If you don't find what you're looking for in one, try the others. Please see a librarian for assistance if you can't find what you're looking for.

Provides mostly full-text access to a variety of collections with coverage as far back as 1980.

Biography Resource Center

Combines award-winning biographies from respected Gale sources with full-text articles from hundreds of periodicals. Search for people both current and historic from all eras and fields of endeavor—based on name, occupation, nationality, ethnicity, birth/death dates and places, or gender, as well as keyword and the full text.

Business and Company Resource Center

Includes company profiles, brand information, rankings, investment reports, company histories, chronologies and periodicals. Search this database to find detailed company and industry news and information.

Analyzes company performance and activity, industry events and trends as well as the latest in management, economics and politics. Access to a combination of broker research reports, trade publications, newspapers, journals and company directory listings, with full text and images available.

Health & Wellness Resource Center

Includes nearly 400 health/medical journals, numerous reference volumes, over 700 health videos, hundreds of pamphlets and health-related articles from 2,200 general interest publications in addition to a broad collection of Gale reference titles.

Health Reference Center Academic Multi-source database provides access to the full text of nursing and allied health journals, plus a wide variety of personal health information sources.

Literature Resource Center

Contains up-to-date biographical information, overviews, full-text literary criticism and reviews on more than 130,000 writers in all disciplines, from all time periods and from around the world. *Includes access to Contemporary*

NAXOS Music Library

The world's largest online classical music library. Currently, it offers streaming access to more than 44,890 CDs with more than 643,400 tracks. On average, 500 new CDs are added to the library every month.

New England Ancestors

Access databases at the New England Historic Genealogical Society. Including cemetery & Bible records & the NEHGS Register. Available at the Ridgewood Public Library.

Newspaper Archive

Tens of millions of historical newspaper pages from around the world. Accessible images from 1759-1977. Available at the Ridgewood Public Library.

Papers of George Washington

Digital edition of Washington's papers with annotations. Regularly updated as project proceeds. Available at the Ridgewood Public Library.

Reference USA
